



# CHILDREN IN NEED

## Non-uniform Day

### Friday 15th November 2019



The School Council has once again decided that they would like to support the Children in Need appeal and have arranged for the following activities to take place:

- A non-uniform day – everyone to get in to the spirit of the day and wear Pudsey and Blush colours – if you can. On this day the children will be able to wear temporary hair colour. School council have asked for special permission for the children (if they wish) to attend in their onesies or pyjamas. This has been agreed provided that they wear suitable underclothes and arms and legs are covered to keep them warm. For the privilege of not wearing uniform, we ask the children to consider making a £1 donation
- Design a Pudsey / Blush Party Outfit Competition - Each child will be given the outline of one of the Children in Need characters and will be asked to design a 'cool' outfit for them to wear. There will be a small prize for the best design in each class and a further three prizes awarded to the best designs across school. The templates for this competition will be given to the children on Friday 8th November for them to work on during the week, with the entry day being the 15<sup>th</sup> November. There will be a small entry fee of 50p for each entry.
- Get Spotty – For a donation of 50p each child will be given the opportunity to have their face painted with Children in Need Spots. Please note we will assume that all parents and carers are happy for their child/ren to have their face painted unless we are informed differently. If you do not wish for your child to have their face painted, please inform your child's class teacher before the big day.
- Cakes and Biscuits Sale – at playtime and lunchtime the School Council will be selling cakes and biscuits. The cakes will be on sale for 30p each and the biscuits for 20p.

**IF YOU THINK YOU COULD MAKE SOME CUPCAKES FOR THE CHILDREN TO SELL, OR PROVIDE A FEW BISCUITS, YOUR SUPPORT WOULD BE VERY MUCH APPRECIATED. PLEASE COULD THESE BE DONATED ON THURSDAY (14<sup>th</sup>), OR FRIDAY (15<sup>th</sup>) MORNING.**

- For example, if your child brings £3.00 on the big day, they can wear non-uniform clothes, take part in the competition, have their face painted with spots and enjoy two cakes and two biscuits (One each at playtime and one each after lunch). Obviously how much you wish to donate is entirely up to you and we will gratefully collect any additional contributions you may wish to make.

Please could we ask that your child brings their money in a sealed labelled envelope. Thank you
