


River Nile	The longest river in the world located in Northeast Africa.		
hieroglyphic	A picture or symbol representing a word, syllable or sound used by the Ancient Egyptians instead of alphabetical letters.		
mummification	If a dead body is mummified, it is preserved. For example by rubbing it with special oils and wrapping it in a cloth.		
papyrus	A tall water plant that grows in Africa. It was used to make a type of paper in Egypt.		
sarcophagus	A large decorative container in which a dead body was placed in ancient times.		
Canopic jars	Four containers with tops in the form of animal heads of the gods, for holding the organs of a mummy.		
pyramid	An ancient stone building with four triangular sloping sides	<p>Misconceptions and Facts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • So far over 130 pyramids have been found in Egypt and archaeologists are still looking for more! • Egyptians used mouldy bread to heal wounds quickly and to stop infection.
