

dog-fighting	This is a battle in the air between fighter aircraft at close range.	<input type="checkbox"/> I know the differences between the Allied nations and the Central Powers	<h3>Misconceptions and Facts</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The United States actually did not become involved in WWI until 1917 – only one year before it ended – after Germany attacked its ships.
Primary source	These tell us about an event or time period and are often created at the time the events happen. E.g. someone's diary from that time – Anne Frank	<input type="checkbox"/> I know that World War One (WWI) started in 1914 and lasted four years until 1918 - WWI	
Secondary source	Secondary sources were made by someone who did not take part in the events or being studied.
