

<b>mammal</b>	An animal that breathes air, has a backbone, has fur or hair, gives birth to live young and feeds young on mother's milk		
<b>amphibian</b>	An animal that lives first in water then on land, have gills initially then lungs. Lay jelly like eggs in water.		
<b>reptile</b>	An animal that lives on land but can go in water. Has lungs. Lay hard-shelled eggs on land		
<b>herbivore</b>	An animal that feeds on plants		
<b>carnivore</b>	An animal that feeds on other animals		
<b>omnivore</b>	An animal that eats both plants and other animals		
<b>human</b>	An animal which is a man, woman, or child
