

wild	A plant (or animal) living and growing in its natural environment		
weed	A wild plant which grows where it is not wanted		
evergreen	A plant that keeps its green leaves throughout the year		
petal	The segments (or parts) of the flower, typically coloured.		
deciduous	A tree or shrub that sheds its leaves annually (every year)		
leaves	Part of a plant, usually green and blade like, attached to a stem or stalk		
root	Part of a plant which keeps it anchored to the ground or to a support. stem	The main part or body of a plant or shrub.

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> To identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants by planting a bean. <input type="checkbox"/> To ask simple questions and recognise that they can be answered in different ways in the context of considering what plants need to grow. <input type="checkbox"/> To identify and name a variety of common wild plants by going on a wild plant hunt. <input type="checkbox"/> To gather and record data to help in answering questions by finding out which wild plant is the most common. <input type="checkbox"/> To identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees by identifying trees by their leaves. <input type="checkbox"/> To identify and classify by classifying leaves as deciduous or evergreen.
