


design specification	A design specification is a detailed plan which explains the materials, tools and process needed to create a product.		
criteria	A list of expectations and standards which a product (or something else) is judged by. They also help in the planning and making process.		
evaluate	To judge the outcome of a process to make something.		
mock-up	This is a scale or full-size model of a design or device, used for practise, design evaluation and other purposes.
